


#### **THE WEB**




#### new GULISTAN






# THE GLOVE WHO LOST HIS HAND Betty Bone




#### **PROUST'S MADELEINE**




### THE TREE AND THE MOON SHADOW


#### **AFTER THE STORM**




#### HERODOTE, THE HEDGEHOG


# LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD, THE SCENE OF THE NIGHTGOWN
