


Sanglier d'automne Chouette d'hiver (Fall Boar Winter Owl)


Ma mère est une panthère (My Mom is a Panther)


De fleurs en fleurs (From Flowers To Flowers)





Since its invention in the 19th century, modern photography has always been present in the book industry. Underrated for a while, often underestimated. photographically-illustrated children's books are cherished by children and more than one artist has been involved in this unique genre. From 1886 to 2021, these books have been significant products of their times, including pedagogical, philosophical and political ideas as well as technical progress related to this medium. Amateurs and famous photographers (Robert Doisneau, Ylla, André Kertész, Ergy Landau, Sarah Moon) created works for this format. Their images go along with texts written by great authors and astounding books came out from these collaborations. Spanning 150 years of photographically-illustrated children's books from Europe and the USA, this monograph explores a captivating aspect of children's book production.
