The publishing house's catalog, which now boasts over 300 titles, offers works that are both popular and high-end, capable of bringing together different types of readers with the same demand for quality.

The house was founded in 2005 by Jean Poderos—a colla borator of André Schiffrin in New York, managing editor of *Beaux Arts magazine*, then editor-in-chief of the art review *Dada* and series director of the associated picture books, Jean Poderos has been working in publishing and the art press for over 30 years.

The house has developed a rich, diverse, and original line of beautiful books, with a manufacturing quality praised by both professionals and the general public. Working with Éditions courtes et longues means opting for a high-quality craftsman for whom every detail counts.

Its catalog also includes prestigious co-editions with national museums and museums in several regions of France. Long-term collaborations with the Louvre Museum, the Musée d'Orsay, the Musée des Confluences, and Sèvres, Cité de la Céramique,

The house has also published artist's books with Roman Opalka, Philippe Ramette, Alain Fleischer, Joana Vasconcelos, Emanuel Proweller, and also Johan Creten and Jean-Michel Othoniel. These books strive to awaken the readers' curiosity and develop their imagination.

Éditions courtes et longues places great importance on its independence, which guarantees, in all circumstances, the freedom to create.

We have been pioneers in the environmental issues in book production and make it a point to print under conditions that respect the planet.





Isabelle Simler's picture books are regularly praised by critics. *Plume* (voted one of the 10 best picture books of 2017 by *The New York Times*), *Blue Hour, The Web*, and *Home* have become staples of our publishing house and bookstores.



A beautiful, fascinating book. A great book!






Me and Others, 2019





Our documentary books offer an introduction to the world around us by exploring history, art, language, and all other forms of expression. When primary school curricula were expanded to include art history in the 2000s, there was nothing on the market that allowed children to learn about it in an age-appropriate way. Éditions courtes et longues pioneered the creation of the "All the Art History" series, offering a dynamic, lively, and playful introduction to art and its various movements. Its legitimacy in this particular field has enabled Éditions courtes et longues to develop the form of children's nonfiction in books co-published

with national museums: Me an the Others and Neanderthal and / (National Museum of Natural History), / Write in Hieroglyphics, Olympic Louvre, This Is Not A Still Life! and From Hercules to Darth Vader, Founding Myths, with the Louvre Museum; Guess What? (Musée des Confluences). Today, youth documentaries continue to evolve and remain one of the company's core activities.

Each naturalistic plate of irises, water lilies, poppies and snowdrops is followed by two plates of decorative motifs inspired by these flowers.



Since opening ten years ago, the Musée des Confluences has established itself as a cultural, social, and urban landmark in Lyon. Built at the tip of the peninsula where the Rhône and Saône rivers meet, in an area that was once deserted, this spectacular building has not only transformed its surroundings but also the lives of the people of Lyon.

The Musée des Confluences, a Living World, is conceived as a collective narrative and is told through the voices of those who imagined, built, and enriched the museum. This book offers an initial perspective on the museum through an in-depth interview with Wolf dPrix, architect at the Austrian firm Coop Himmelb(l)au, providing valuable insight into the building's architectural origins.

Memoirs of a Collector

Born into a family of Russian nobility exiled in Belgium, Pierre Apraxine quickly distinguished himself by his unique way of looking at art. Attracted by the creative effervescence that emerged in New York in the late 1960s, he decided to try his luck there. There he became a respected curator and, above all, a major collector of vintage photographs on behalf of paper magnate

Howard Gilman, with whom he built one of the world's largest private collections of vintage photographs. This collection now belongs to the Metropolitan Museum. Pierre Apraxine had an unerring eye: until late in life, he advised leading American and European collectors and dealers on photography and contemporary art.


