Lou is bored and doesn't know how to keep herself busy. One day, she stumbles upon an old photo of her mother and grandmother shaking the sand from their boots after going to the beach. The following day, she joins her mother on her walk. When they return from the beach, they smile, remove their boots, and shake off the sand, in exactly the same way that Lou's mother and grandmother did decades earlier. Together mother and daughter discover a way to keep precious traditions alive through small acts that speak volumes about life and love.

Odile Santi's soft, warm hues bring Niels Thorez's delicate, pared-back text to life in this eloquent tale of intergenerational sharing.
