THE COLOURS OF THE SEASONS

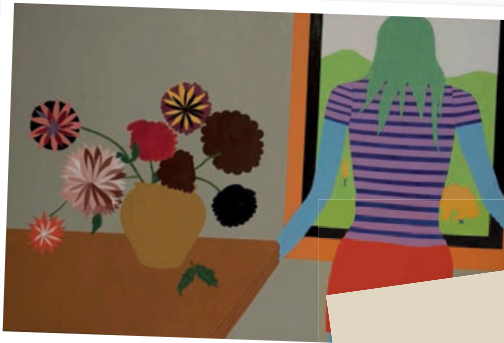

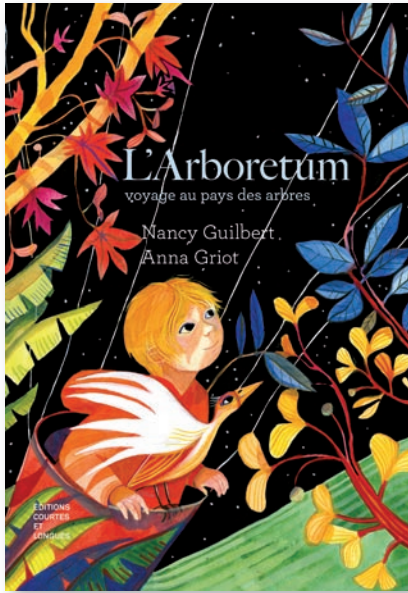

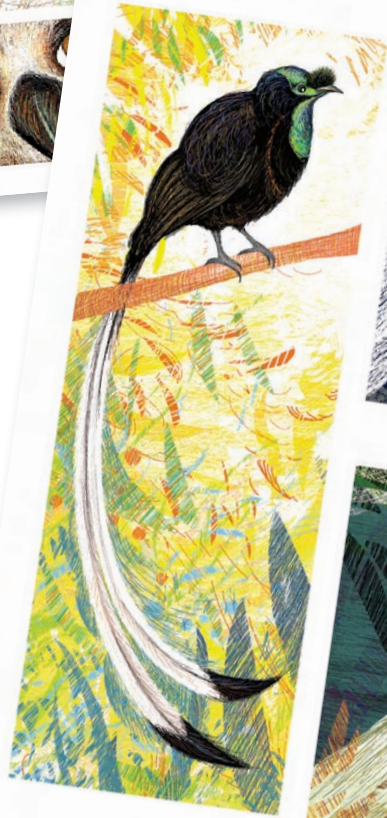
When turned upside down, *Oh My Bird!* tells another story. Or rather, the same story, but this time using the names of birds that evoke love rather than disaccord.

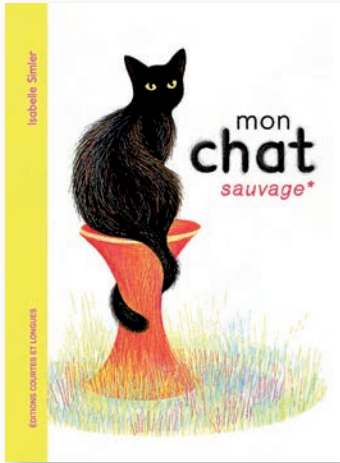
In the middle of the book readers will rediscover the birds cited, depicted in a more naturalistic fashion.
