Magnificent and repulsive, Oswald sets the scene for a crazy chase that has Chiméri looking to escape her pursuers and return to the human world, much to the dismay of her new companions, especially one little girl who looks astonishingly like her.

Célia Garino's novel is filled with fantastic adventures that draw on myriad myths and tales for inspiration, including those of Homer, Lewis Carroll and Hayao Miyazaki.






FROM MY WINDOW



Nancy Guilbert, ill. by Valérie Michel




ARBORETUM
