Bien qu'elle sa soit toujours défendue du rapprochement de ses créations avec colles de Menet, elle s'était installée à Véthouil. village tout près de Giverny cé Monet conçut um auvres après 1890. Mitchell se nourrit. de la nature, de ses variations, de ses rythmes lumineux, tout on se détachant d'une représentation immédiate et littérale.

La couleur comme

a couleur, est-ce cela qui fait un artista? Sa capacité à les choisir, è les mélanger, à les opposer? Regarder une toile de Claude Monet, c'est comme plonger dans la couleur. Une couleur vibrante, harmonieuse, puissante, qui semble envahir. l'œuvre tout entière et charme nos yeux. Dès ses premières œuvres, le jeune Claude Monet porta un intérêt particulier à la couleur. Il avait en tête la locan d'Eugène Delacreix et avait fait sienns la théorie des contrastes colorés où les couleurs appeaces - le bleu et l'orange, par exemple se répondent et s'exaltent, faisant jaillir la lumière. Le procédé des séries le conduisit à choisir un motif - la façade de la cathédrale de Rouen, une meule de foin, les nénuphers de l'étang de son jardin et de le répéter, au gré des jours, des heures. du passage des nuages et de celui du soleil. Le sujet de sa toile devenait alors, moins que le monument, le foin ou les fleurs, la variation colorée et lumineuse
