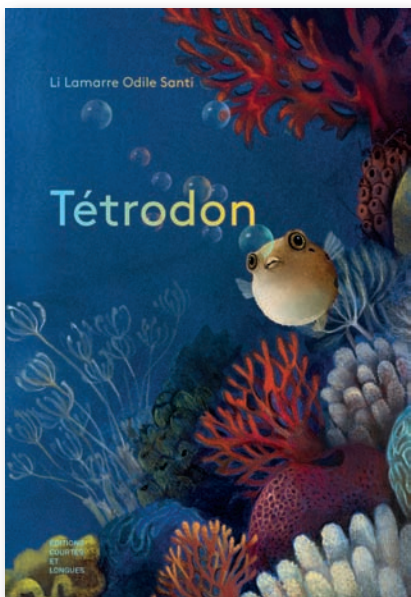

TETRAODON

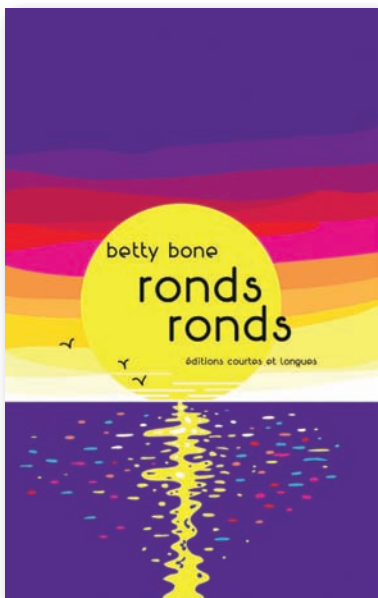

WHAT A STRANGE ROOM!

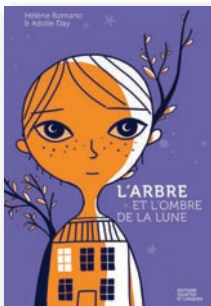

When turned upside down,

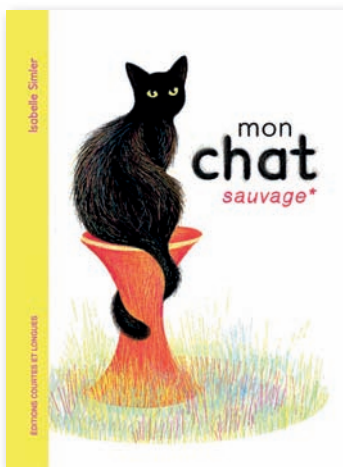
Oh My Bird! tells another story. Or rather, the same story, but this time using the names of birds that evoke love rather than discord.

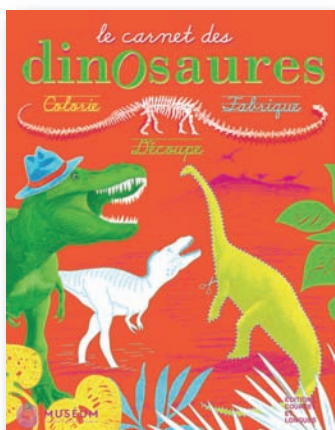
MY PET SNAIL

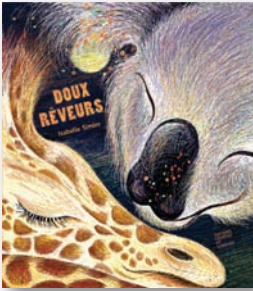
HUGO PRATT, HORIZON LINES
