


Will she find a place to lay her eggs?







THE STORY

Little by little, he discovers his other qualities and regains confidence in himself. He finally agrees to have his wool shorn and, once freed of his heavy fleece, he joyfully **returns to his family and friends.**



THE STORY

A little brother, living in a new house, arriving at a new school...These are **difficult changes** for a child! To fit in and be liked by his new classmates, the child agrees to play games that adults must not know about, games that are not funny, games that aren't really games.

One day, the child won't refuse to play the "indigo dream", a pretty name to hide an atrocious game of strangulation that will cause the death of one of the participants.

The child then becomes aware that **his life is the most precious thing he has:** a treasure that belongs to him and that he must protect.

THE BOOK

With this essential book, **Hélène Romano** (PhD in Psychopathology, specialized in children trauma) explains to children why certain "games" can have consequences that they must protect themselves against. The issue of **bullying** is made that much more difficult to address by the fact that children may find themselves alternately **victim**, **witness and ringleader**.


Hélène Romano's incisive tale concludes with a page offering **practical advice** to help parents talk to their children about these types of games and the danger they pose for themselves and those around them.

THE STORY

It is August 31, 2002 and twelve-year-old Marieke won't be making any more sand castles on the Ostend beach with her favorite cousin. She feels like her **childhood is coming to an end** and is filled with regret. Ever since life as she knew it was destroyed at the same time as the twin towers on September 11, 2001, her existence has been a series of **disappointments**, from her parents' **divorce**, to the terrible lies told by her beloved grandmother, the revolting presence of her mother's boyfriend and her best friend Zelda's obsession with men.

Upon returning to Paris the day before school starts, she isn't expecting her father to announce that he is moving in with his young girlfriend and her four-year-old son. Marieke feels like her world is falling apart. It's too much. She can't bear it any longer! This time, **everything has to change.** Whatever it takes.

THE AUTHOR

Élisabeth Brami has published more than one hundred books, including award-winning titles that have been translated into foreign languages by various publishers. She worked as a psychologist in a day hospital for over thirty years, providing treatment for teenagers and organizing writing, reading and photography workshops to help them heal. As an author, she seeks to create characters who give readers of all ages the strength they need to fundamentally change the way they live. She has taken an active role in associations that promote reading and creativity among children.

THE BOOK

Élisabeth Brami describes the collapse of the certainties of childhood and the **bittersweet feelings** of regret and bizarre sensations that often accompany one's early teen years. Indeed, girls often find themselves both wanting and dreading **inevitable changes** as they metamorphose into young women.

For Marieke, life is an uninterrupted series of disappointments, with the adults around her continually failing her. As summer comes to an end and she realizes that nothing will ever be the same again, she comes to understand that if she wants to be free, **it is up to her to take charge of her own life.**

EXCERPT

That morning, Marieke was awoken by the kitchen radio playing a most appropriate song. The voice singing was innocent, almost childlike:

We packed away our summer vacation In cardboard suitcases How sad it is

The rest of the song had been drowned out by the hum of the dishwasher. But it was sad indeed, and Marieke knew just how sad! She also knew that things couldn't continue this way any longer. She felt like she was trapped in a tight cage. Her head was filled with cries of "Never again!" and "No way!"




THE STARS ARE DYING IN THE SKY NEW
