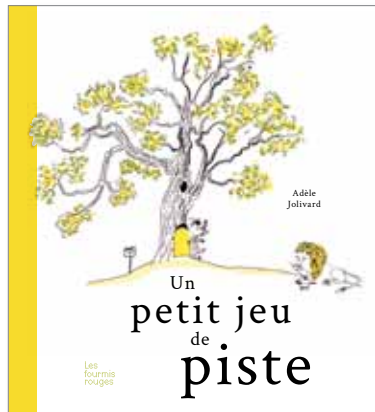
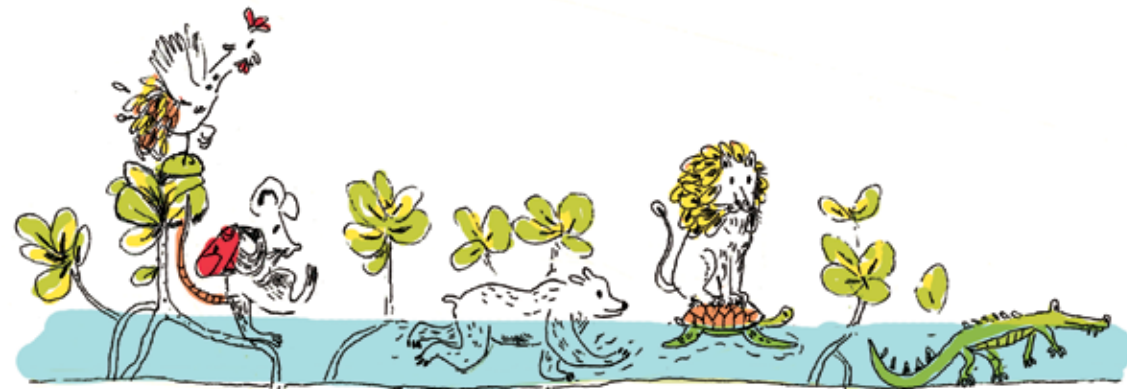

## The Treasure Hunt

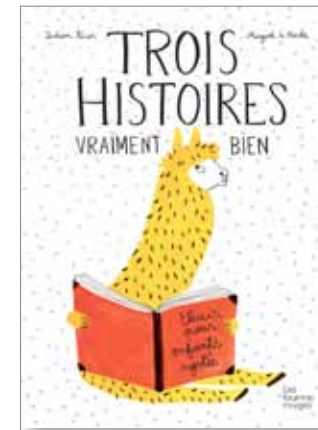
