Animaux à compter (Counting Animals)


After Alphabet of Plants and Animals, Émilie Vast introduces little ones to numbers

A doe, two swans, three foxes... the double-page spreads offer counting numbers from 1 to 10 animals. The left-hand pages present four ways to represent numbers: with numbers, letters, squares, and fingers.

On the right—hand pages, children have fun counting a collection of bears, mice, squirrels, or snails, and thus associate the number of animals with their numbers.

BOUUUUUT! (BOUUUUUT!)



Kiwikidiwi, mon grand ami l'ornithorynque! (Kiwikidiwi, My Good Friend the Platypus)




Le tambour (The Drum)






L'énigme de l'île flottante (The Riddle of the Floating Island)

Le mystère de l'eucalyptus (The Mystery of the Eucalyptus)





Philippe Dumas refreshes the Brothers Grimm story with his illustrations, highlighting its eternal nature as children enact it playing in a garden.



Jacques de Roussan Au-delà du soleil Beyond the Sun

Night time. While sleeping, Pierre dreams of space: his rocket leaves Earth to explore the solar system. Moons, satellites, stars, comets and planets, Pierre discovers the different astral bodies. But he has to be careful, the universe could be dangerous, the explosion of a star or a meteor shower could damage his spaceship. Tonight, Pierre will live a magical night.

In this splendid picture book from 1972, Jacques de Roussan opened up the way to space to young readers. Composed in collage, the book was screen printed in 1000 copies. The Canadian Library Association selected it as one of the most beautiful illustrated books for children in the 1970s.
