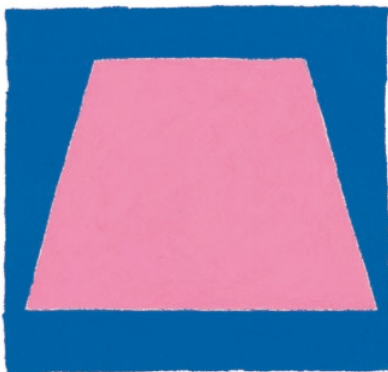
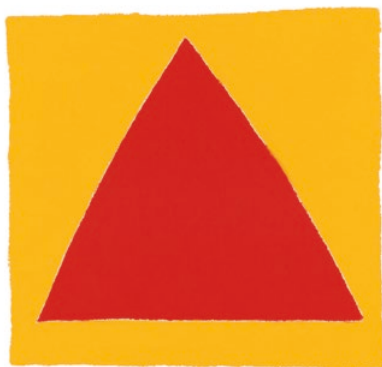
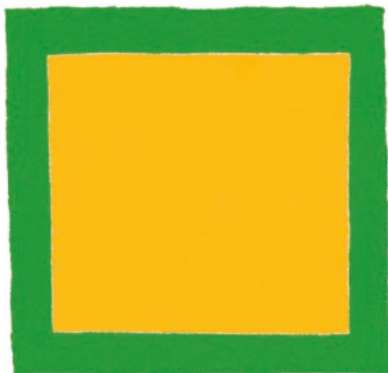
Quelque part le soir (Somewhere in the Evening)

Somewhere in the evening... Ici comes back from grocery store. Ici pushes a toy car along. Ici puts on pyjamas.

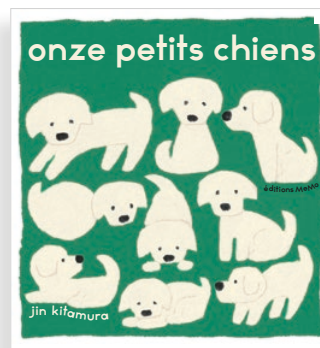
Somewhere in the evening... Éla parks her wood car. Éla does the famous evening dance. Éla looks for her lovie.

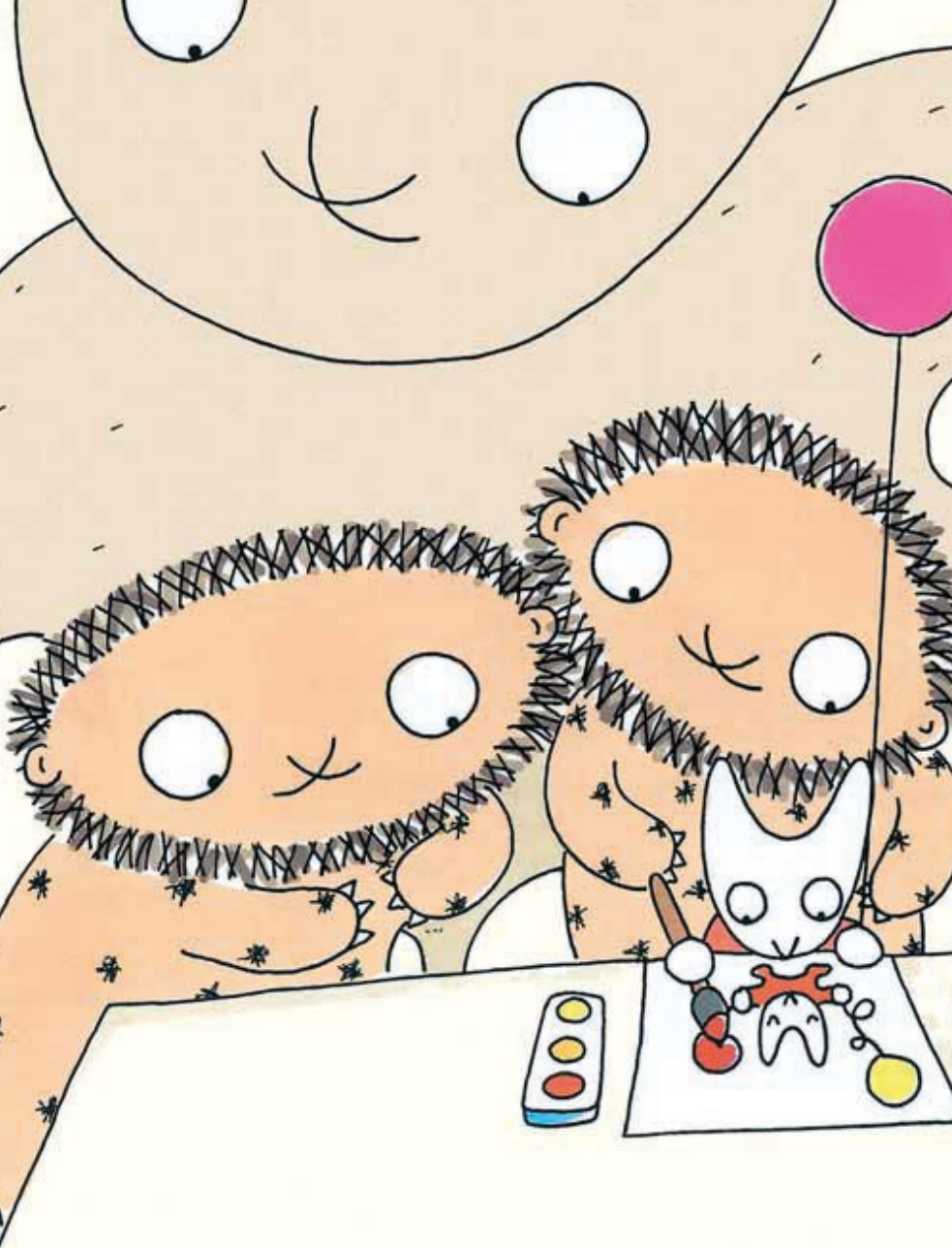
Onze petits chiens (Eleven Little Dogs)

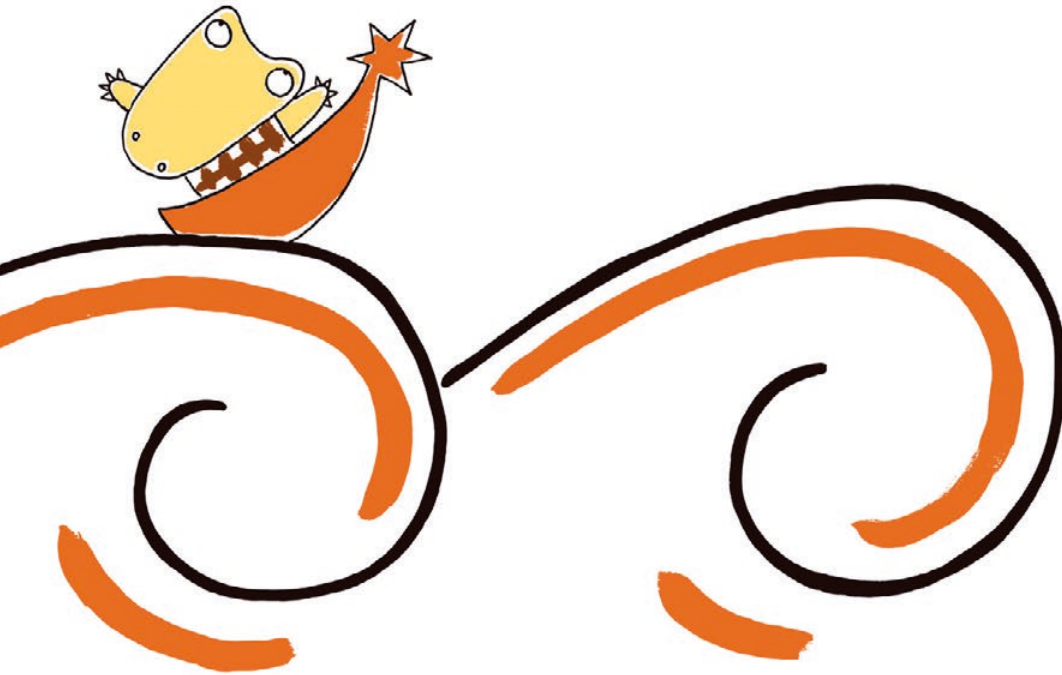

*Mouse, my mouse, you are a mouse.
Animals have their kings and queens.

queen of mouse. (...) At the slightest
fright, the hedgehog curls up into a
ball. But he always comes out again.
The snail retracts one or both eyes at
the slightest breath of wind. But he
inevitably puts them back out after a
while. And you, Mouse, my mouse, like
all the little mice in the world who are
learning to walk, you sometimes fall.
But you always bravely get back up.*

By playing with sounds and rhythm, Malika Doray creates a nursery rhyme to read and read again for the greatest pleasure of toddlers. With her easily recognizable, gentle style, she reassures them of the permanence of the world and encourages them to gain confidence in themselves.

The snow has fallen and covered everything. Tiny Little Thing doesn't recognize the forest anymore, and all that white is blinding her... But where have all the colours gone?

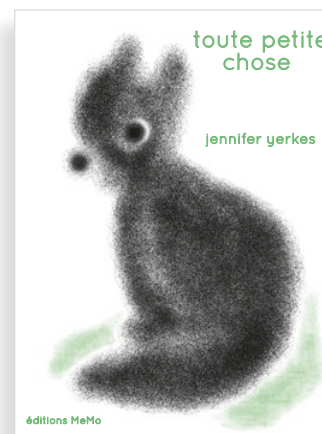

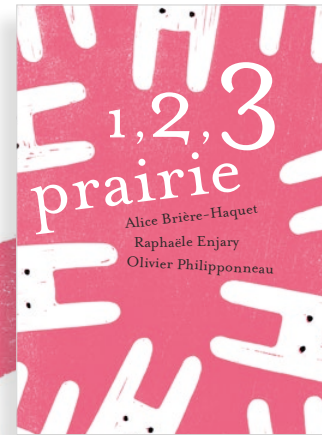
Toute petite chose (Tiny Little Thing)

1 rabbit + 1 rabbit = 10 rabbits...*

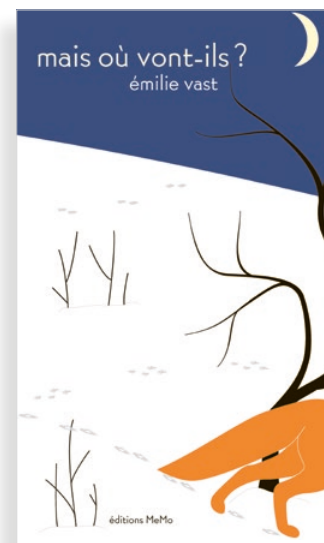

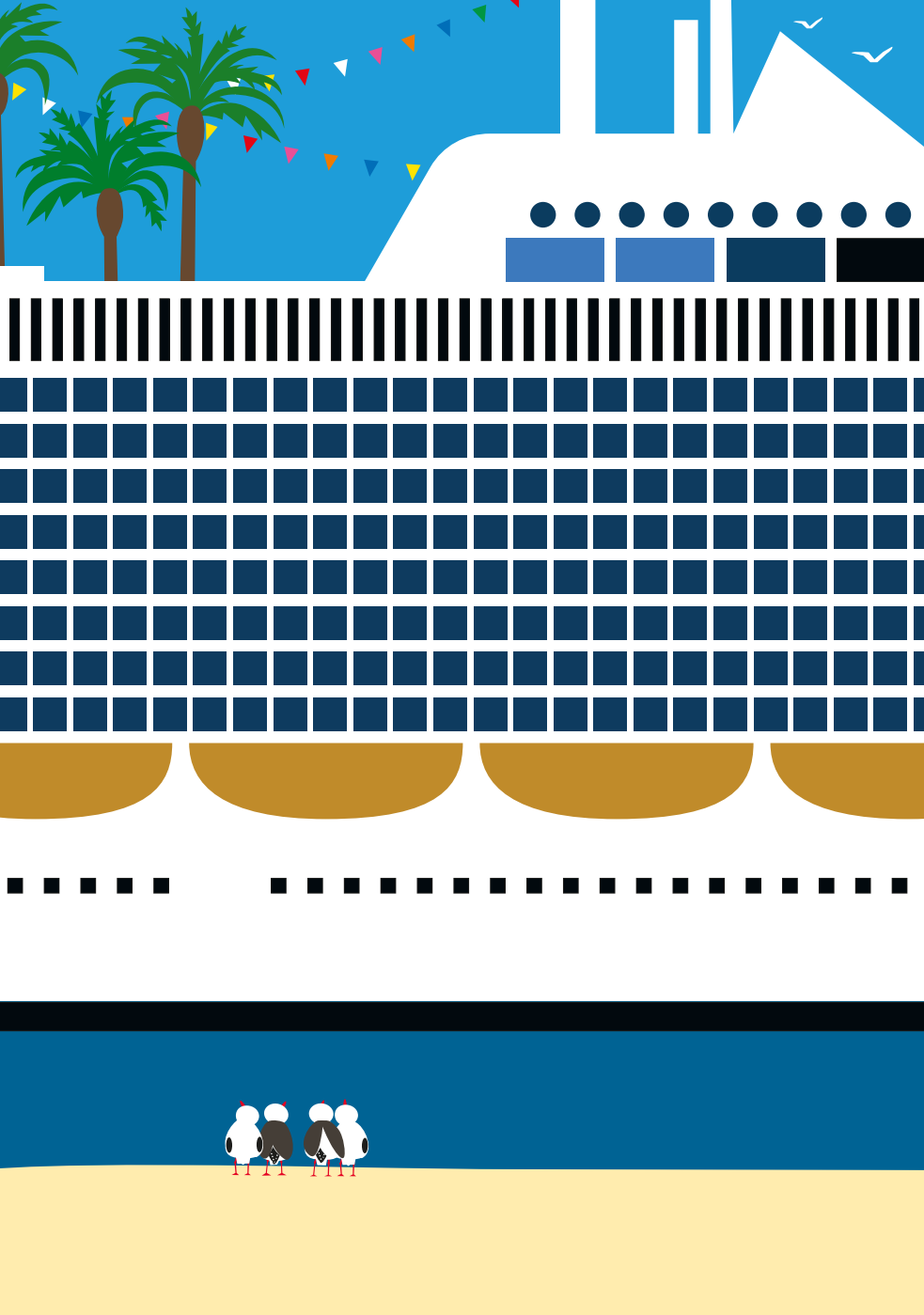

Là où le vent me mène (Wherever the Wind Takes Me)

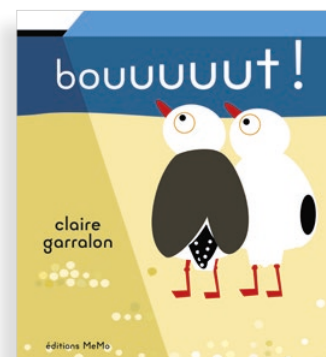

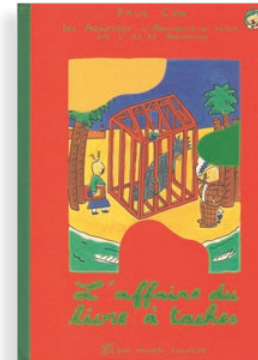

Animaux à compter (Counting Animals)

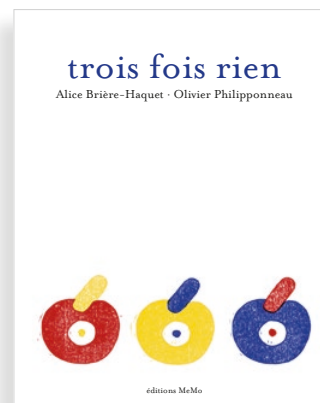
Émilie Vast

After *Alphabet of Plants and Animals*, Émilie Vast introduces little ones to numbers.

A doe, two swans, three foxes... the double-page spreads offer counting numbers from 1 to 10 animals. The left-hand pages present four ways to represent numbers: with numbers, letters, squares, and fingers.

On the right-hand pages, children have fun counting a collection of bears, mice, squirrels, or snails, and thus associate the number of animals with their numbers.
