
### Les trois gibbons et le chant du colibri (The Three Gibbons and the Hummingbird' Song)


### L'imagier de l'été (The Summer's Picture Book)



### Mon bison (My Buffalo)


"The first time I saw it, it was springtime. I was in the tall grass, I couldn't see an awful lot being all of four years old."






It is the first time that Fanette Mellier is working for children (and more precisely early readers), after an outstanding career in print illustration.
