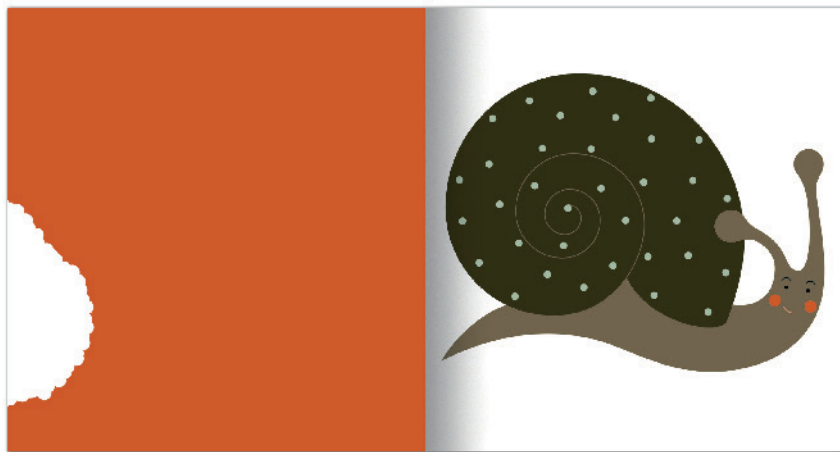

### Qui a mangé ? (Who Ate That)

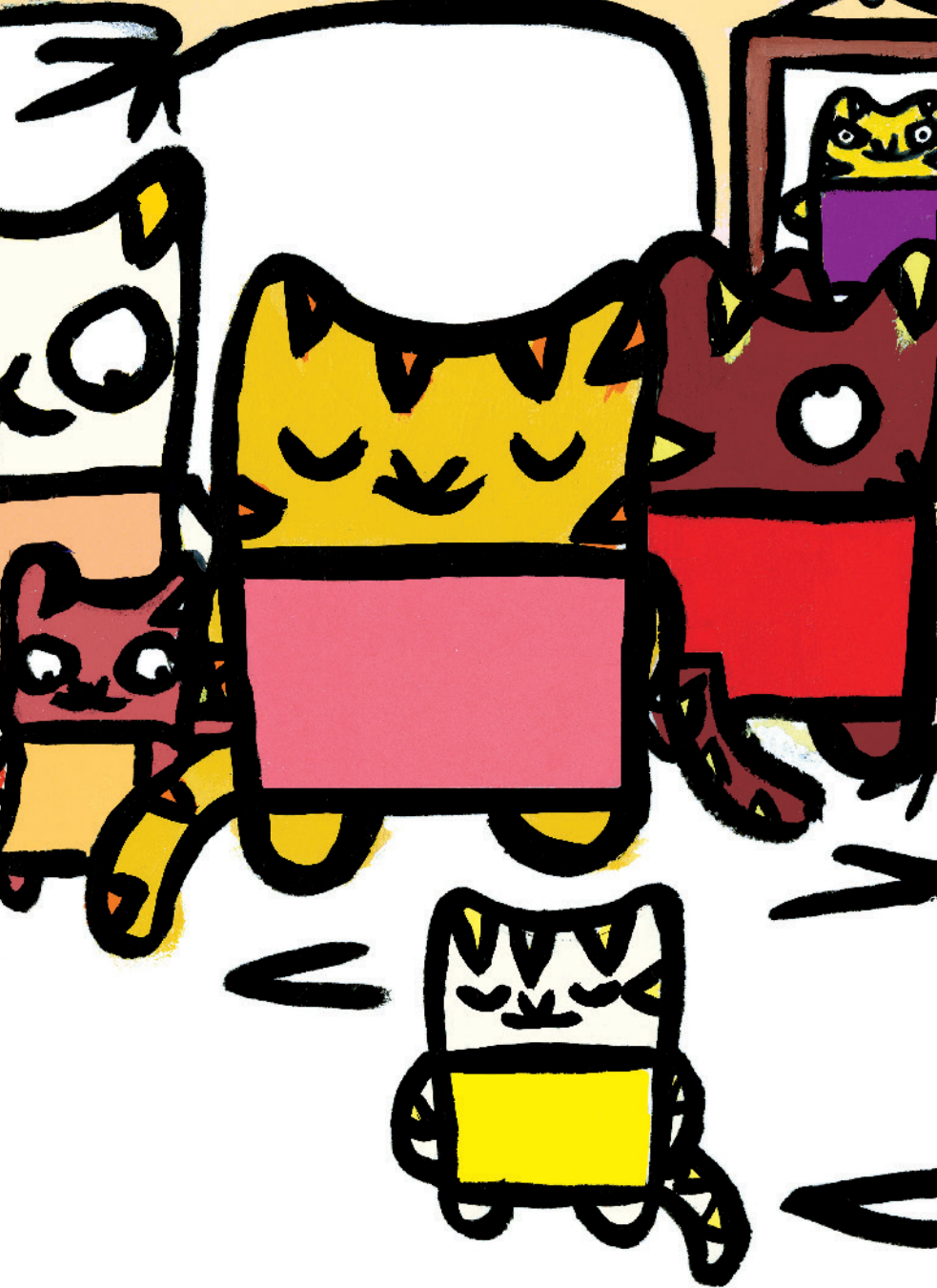

As with all children, his otherness will be taken into account, even as he becomes part of a family with its richness, similarities, and differences.

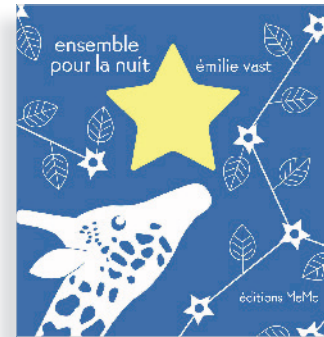
A copy of *Small Tiger* was given to all babies born in the city of Grenoble in 2010 and 2011.

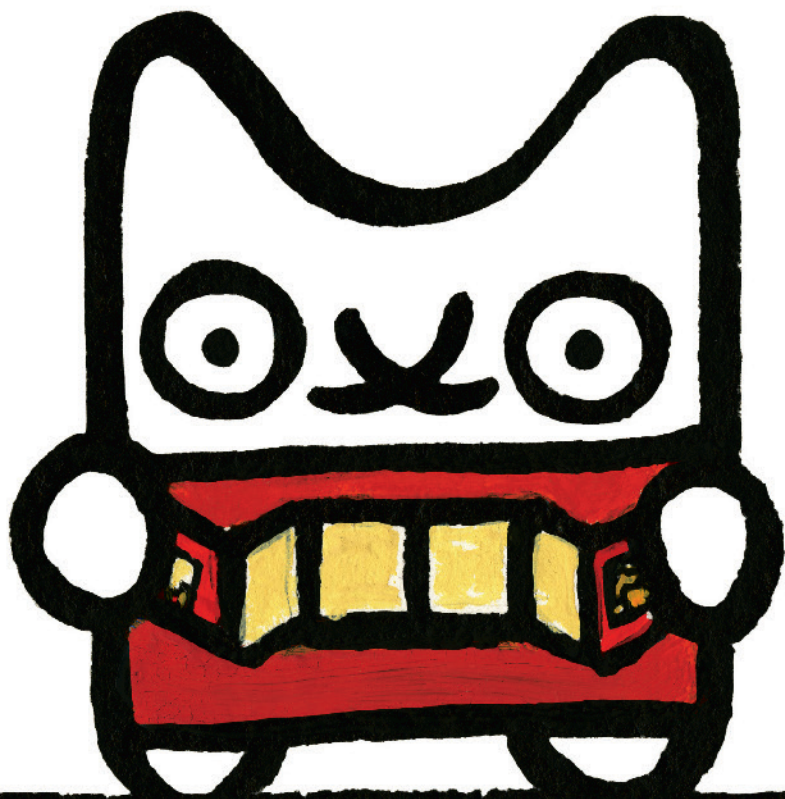
## Ensemble pour la nuit (Together at Night)

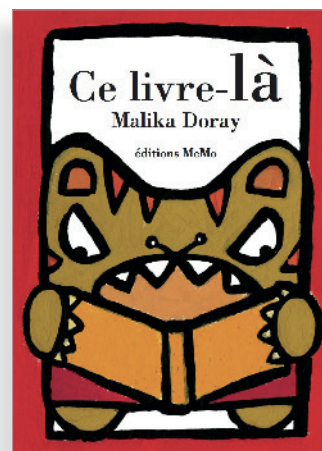

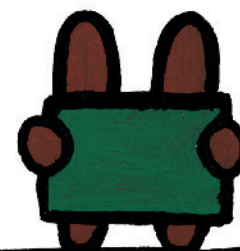
### Ce livre-là (That Book)

A book that unfolds as one long, colourful concertina, full of every possible good reason to pick it up and read, again and again !

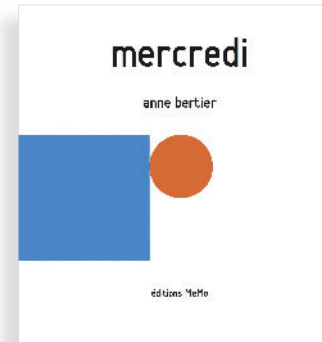
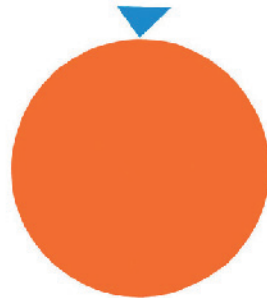

## Mercredi (Wednesday)

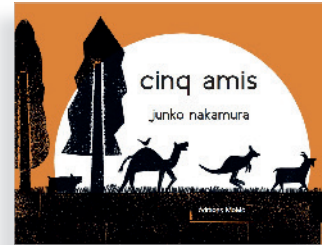

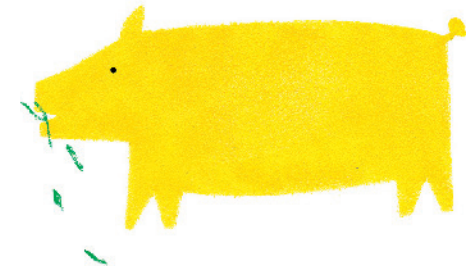

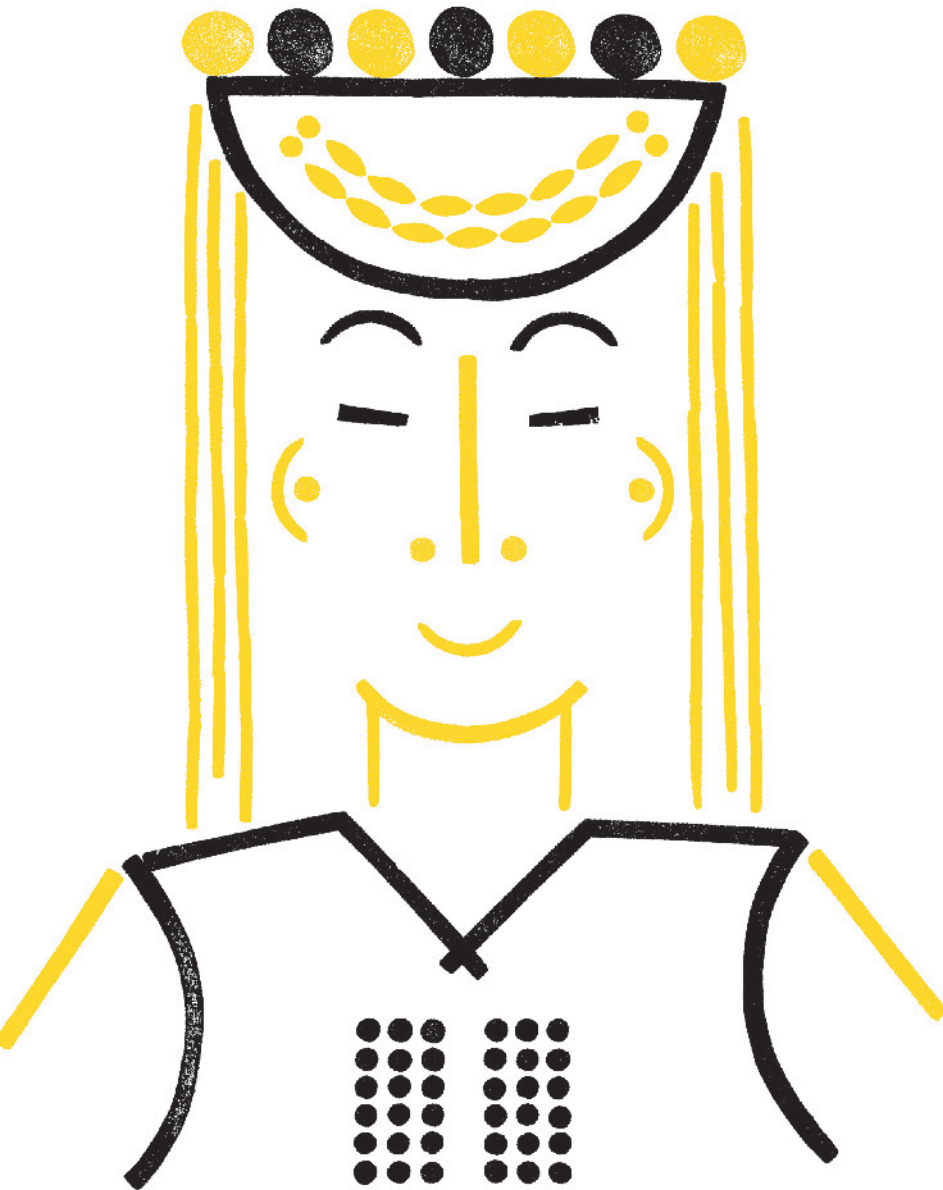
## Toc-toc ville (Toc-toc City)

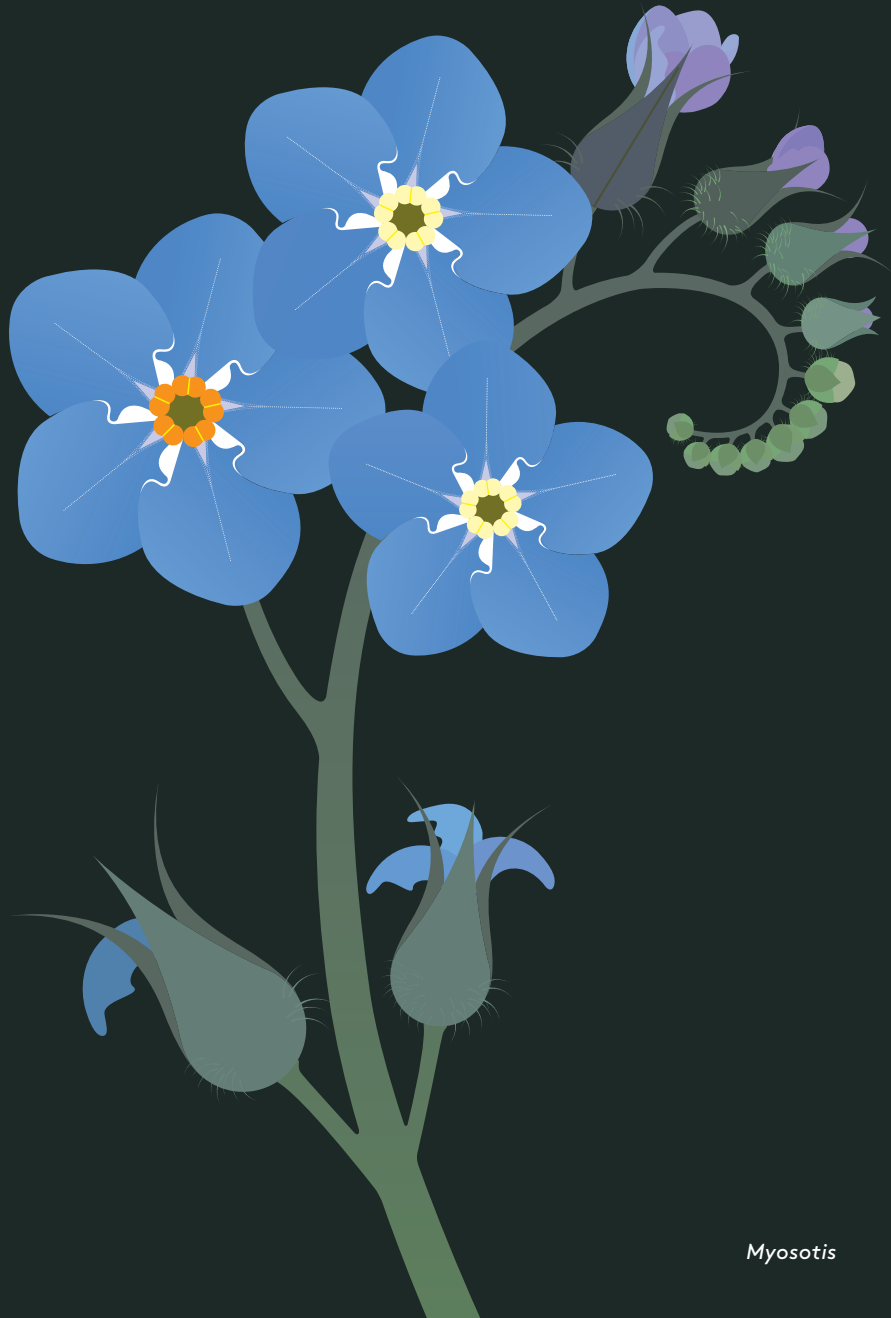
### ABC des peuples (Peoples of the World)

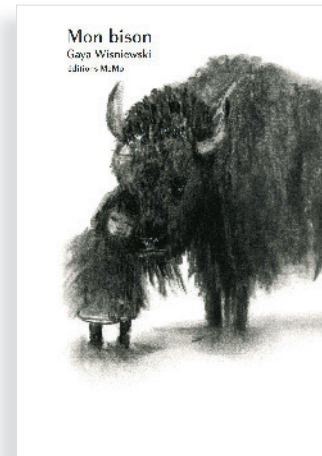
Across big double-page spreads, Anne Crausaz shows how flowers have developed ingenious adaptations to survive.
