Five senses in pictures

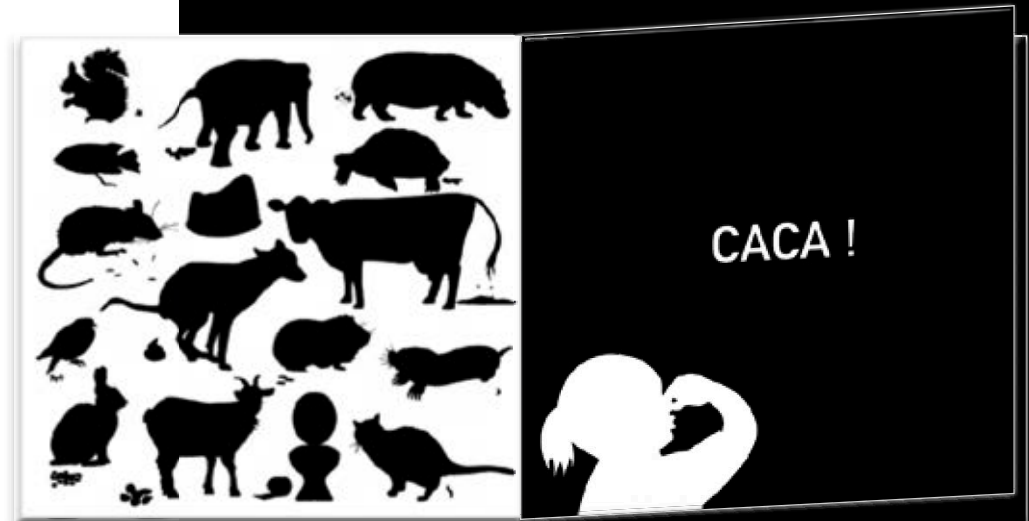

by Anne Crahay

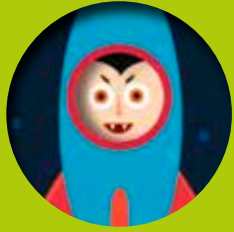

Children will thus become familiar with a culture as rich as it is fascinating!

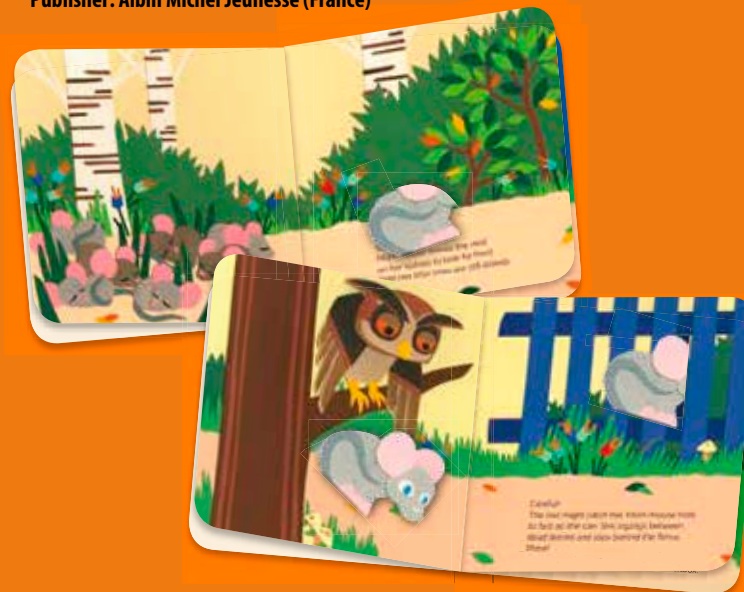
Where Are You Going, Little Mice?
