### **LUIGI SERIES**


by Marie Quentrec


# My Little Family



## THWART THE TRAPS SERIES


by Pascale Hédelin, illustrated by Benjamin Strickler and Julien Tixier

Each documentary is made of ten large and very detailed illustrations and invites the reader to explore a scene related to a theme (history, science, nature, sport, art).
