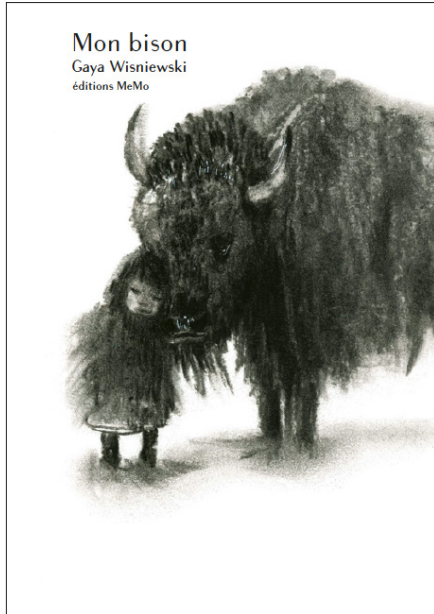

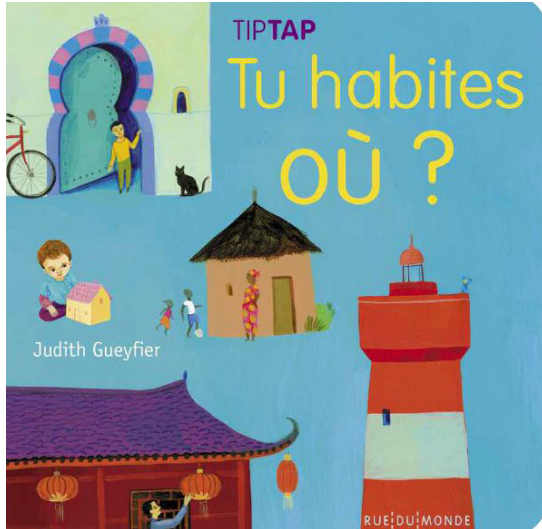

“That’s because he’s got big teeth! ”

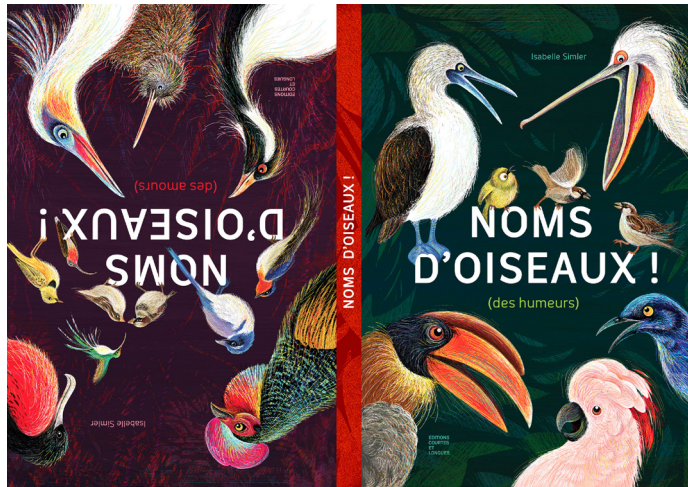
“Oh no, it’s the walrus who’s got big teeth! ”

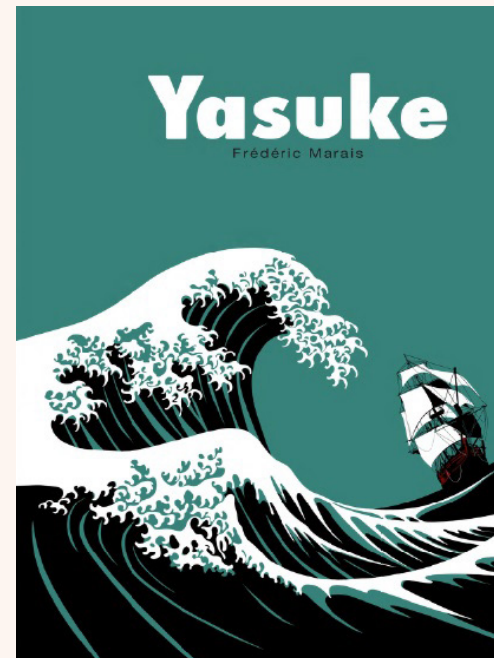
Who's racist nowadays? Me, you, the others? Also, where does the idea of us belonging to different races come from? Aren't we all human beings?
